## Evaluating A Photo Essay

- □ Quality of pictures?
- □ Do the provide a complete coverage of the subject?
- □ Do the photos "add" to the discussion i.e. "a 1000 words"?
- □ How good is the accompany text to provide context or analysis?
- □ How good are the captions?

## Creating a Photo Essay

- □ Pick a topic
- □ Do some research
- □ Find your "thesis"
- □ Itemize the shots that would support your thesis
- □ Record the emotions that need to be dislpayed to support thesis
- □ Plan your shots
- □ Create the accompanying text/captions
